



THCD Parking and Safe Driving Guidelines 2026

To help ensure the continued operation of our daycare and the safety of all children, families, and neighbors, we kindly ask for your cooperation with the following important information for our neighborhood and community.

Parking & Traffic Guidelines

- 1. Careful Use of the Driveway** — Please enter and exit the driveway slowly and with extreme caution. Any three-point turns or U-turns must also be completed at very low speeds. While we understand time constraints, safety is non-negotiable. An accident involving a parent, child, or pedestrian would be catastrophic and could have serious consequences for all parties involved.
- 2. Slow Speeds for Safety** — For the safety of our children, families, and neighbors, please maintain slow driving speeds while approaching and leaving the daycare.
- 3. Driveway Parking & Sidewalk Access** — You may park in our driveway; please park to one side to allow room for a second car. Please do not park blocking the sidewalk — pull in all the way, slowly and carefully, as our neighborhood cats sometimes sit or walk through our driveway. Our neighbors have shared concerns that blocked sidewalks prevent safe passage for pedestrians, families, and pets.
- 4. Phone Calls or Longer Stops** — We completely understand that urgent work or emergency phone calls occasionally arise. If you need to remain parked for longer than a quick pick-up, please park further away so closer spaces remain available and traffic continues to flow smoothly.
- 5. Street Parking** — Whenever possible, and even if it is less convenient, please use available street parking further back. This greatly helps reduce congestion near the daycare entrance.

Our neighbors have generally been very supportive and understanding of our daycare. However, repeated complaints could jeopardize our ability to continue operating in this residential area.
